Three \$5,000 Branstad-Reynolds Agriculture Scholarships

Applicant should be an incoming freshman in the fall of 2021 who plans to attend an Iowa community college, college or university and pursue a degree in the field of agriculture. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

One \$7,000 Bruce Rastetter Scholarship

The applicant must currently be a **Sophomore or a Junior** in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is involved in the **Agricultural Entrepreneurship Initiative**.

One \$7,000 Bruce Rastetter Scholarship

The applicant must currently be a **Sophomore or a Junior** in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant in **Biorenewable Resources**.
