### **Four \$5,000 Branstad-Reynolds Agriculture Scholarships**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate attending an Iowa community college, college or university and pursuing a degree in the field of agriculture. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

### **One \$8,000 Bruce Rastetter Entrepreneurial Scholarship**

The applicant must currently be a sophomore or a junior in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is involved in the Agricultural Entrepreneurship Initiative.

### **One \$8,000 Bruce Rastetter Biorenewable Resources Scholarship**

The applicant must be a current sophomore or a junior in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is interested in Biorenewable Resources.

### **One \$8,000 Bruce Rastetter Agricultural Sustainability Scholarship**

The applicant must be a current sophomore or a junior in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is interested in sustainability.

### **One \$5,000 Mark Pearson Memorial Entrepreneurial Scholarship**

The applicant must be a current sophomore or junior in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is involved in the Agricultural Entrepreneurship Initiative and show a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

### **One \$5,000 Sinclair Tractor Agronomy Scholarship – Agricultural Business**

Applicant must currently be enrolled in the Department of Ag Business at Iowa State University with a minimum of 80 college credit hours. Applicant must be from southeast Iowa, come from a strong farm background, have a strong background in FFA, and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities.

### **One \$5,000 Cargill/Provimi Agriculture Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours. Applicant should have a strong agricultural background involving 4-H and FFA and demonstrate leadership abilities while being involved with activities.

### **One \$5,000 ISF Beef Champion Supporters Scholarship**

Applicant should be an incoming freshman or undergraduate for 2023 who plans to attend a community college, college or university and pursue a degree in the field of agriculture. Career focus in the agriculture industry is expected. Applicant must have a strong agriculture background involving 4-H and/or FFA and have also demonstrated community, state, or national leadership activities. Applicant must have exhibited beef project(s) at the Iowa State Fair in 4-H and/or FFA.

### **Two \$2,500 ISF Beef Champion Supporters Scholarship**

Applicant should be an incoming freshman or undergraduate who for 2023 plans to attend a community college, college or university and pursue a degree in the field of agriculture. Career focus in the agriculture industry is expected. Applicant must have a strong agriculture background involving 4-H and/or FFA and have also demonstrated community, state, or national leadership activities. Applicant must have exhibited beef project(s) at the Iowa State Fair in 4-H and/or FFA. One applicant will be selected from each of four quadrants in the state of Iowa.

### **One \$ 2,500 Aaron Boysen Memorial Scholarship by Kent Nutrition Group, Inc**

Applicant should be an undergraduate in the fall of 2023 at any Iowa community college, college, or university and pursuing a degree in the field of animal agriculture, specifically beef or swine. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H, and/or FFA, have shown swine and/or cattle, and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in the beef or swine industries after graduation.

### **One \$2,500 Iowa Agribusiness Radio Network Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA leadership as well as livestock projects. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

### **One \$2,000 Dixie and Harold Hodson Swine Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who has a strong desire to remain active in the swine industry after graduation.

### **One \$2,000 IFAA Christian Brothers Swine Participation Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours with emphasis in swine. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities. Preference will be given to applicant who has a strong desire to remain active in the swine industry after graduation.

### **One \$2,000 Schlutz Family Beef Breeding Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate attending an Iowa community college, college or university and have a strong background in beef projects and activities. Preference in selection will be given to applicant who shows current and prior involvement in their beef breeding program and are associated with beef breed associations with a desire to remain active in the beef breeding industry after graduation.

### **One \$2,000 Brice Leonard Memorial Sheep Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA sheep projects and a strong emphasis in sheep while at ISU. Preference will be given to applicant who is active in Block and Bridle Club and shows a desire to remain active in the sheep industry after graduation.

### **One \$1,500 Iowa Purebred Swine Council Scholarship**

Applicant must currently have 60 or more credit hours in Animal Science or related curriculum at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA swine projects and a strong emphasis in swine while at ISU. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in the purebred swine industry after graduation.

### One \$1,500 Carolyn Smith Trust Scholarship

Applicant must currently be an incoming freshman or undergraduate attending an Iowa community college, college or university and have a strong agriculture background involving 4-H and/or FFA activities. Preference will be given to applicant who is interested in Agricultural Business.

### One \$1,500 Fareway Meat and Grocery Scholarship

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA leadership as well as livestock projects. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

### One \$1,250 Rain & Hail Insurance Scholarship

The applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University pursuing a degree in Ag Business or Ag Finance with a strong agriculture background involving 4-H and/or FFA. Applicant must have completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours.

Applicant must be a current undergraduate enrolled in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University. Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA projects and activities and demonstrate leadership while being involved in activities at the college level. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in agriculture after graduation.

Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in the swine industry after graduation.

Applicant must have a strong background in 4-H and/or FFA swine projects and a strong emphasis in swine while at ISU. Preference will be given to applicant who shows a strong desire to remain active in the swine industry after graduation.

### **One \$1,000 Key Cooperative Scholarship**

Applicant must be a current undergraduate in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and completed a minimum of 45 college credit hours. Preference will be given to student interested in Animal Science and/or Agronomy, Ag Business or Ag Studies.

### **One \$1,000 Tall Corn Meat Goat Wether Association Scholarship**

Applicant should be an undergraduate in Agriculture at any Iowa community college, college or university or an incoming freshman at any Iowa community college, college, or university in the fall of 2023. Applicant must have a strong background in meat goat production and/or exhibiting, project and activities.
